Organisational Introduction / Profile

HRPF Pakistan started its voluntarily journey from a launched a campaign against human rights violations in Pakistan. This campaign initiated by a group of devoted young and energetic social activists of across the Sindh Pakistan. The forum was working since 2001 with participatory approach with civil society organizations, print & electronic media, legal activists, students and other segment of society. The forum volunteers decided and undertook efforts to register it under society's Act 1860 in January 28, 2019 with Registration No: **SK/1927 of 2018-2019**.

The volunteers of this forum have delivered their voluntary services and time to gather people and mobilize them to work for the development of area from the platform of "Human Rights Protection Forum Pakistan" and were, succeed to motivate the people who helped to start charity activities in the same year.

In the starting days, **HRPF** worked as charity organization, **HRPF** members got some training organized by some NGOs working on District level. This provides the opportunity to the organization for strategic shift from charity to development approach. Now we are at the stage to adopt right based approach in development.

HRPFwith support of philanthropists including local bodies, district administration, NGOs and media representatives organized various seminars, rallies, awareness walk, distributed food and nonfood items (NFIs) winterization kit among poor families without any discrimination at any stage. Several organizations in the beginning helped in its institutional development as well as development of program.

HRPF started its activities from Social mobilization to the empowerment of rural communities, protections of their rights and provide them basic services and facilities from Government & other stack holders. It then started surveys, training to community activists, advocacy for development rights and ending violence against women, natural resources management, health, education, human rights and empowerment of all other marginalized sections of the society.


Executive committee is currently working as Board of directors too.

05/07/2023

14/08/2023

The rally was led by central and provincial office-bearers. Along with the officials and workers of the Human Rights Protection Forum Pakistan, a large number of patriotic Pakistanis also participated in the rally. The prime objective was to aware the people for the importance of an independent land.



06/09/2023

A donation was collected by the members of HRPF for celebrating Deffence Day (Youm - Difaa) to pay sulute to the martyrs of Pak Fojj. For this pupose ralies were taken out at pacca Chang, Akri and Kot Laloo. The slogans were raised in favor of Pak forces and saluted the marters of Pak army. It shows the unity and love with army of our country. At the last the prayers were offered for the forgiveness of the martyrs.



19/09/2023

With the donations collected by the members of the Human Rights Protection Forum, warm blankets and plastic tarpaulins were distributed to 300 families affected at different areas of District Khairpur such as Handyari and Sui Gas of taluka Thari Mirwah. Through this action all above victims were saved from severe cold and rainwater. The Human Rights Protection Forum will always stand by the people affected by the floods in every difficulty.



20/09/2023

HRPF conducted survey in Nara (deserted and deprived area of Khairpur Mir's) and found that most of girls/women were unmarried due to unavailability of dowry. So the HRPF extended its support to deserving families in Nara by providing dowry assistance to 2 brides , helping them to begin a new chapter of their lives with dignity and ease. Through compassion and community-based support, HRPF continues its mission to stand with families in need and bring hope, relief, and smiles to those starting their journey toward a better future. HRPF aims to work for the better and independent life of a person after mairage.



04/12/2023

With the donations collected by the members of the Human Rights Protection Forum a program was organized in the areas of Akri Chondagi and Thari Merwah to promote Sindh Cultural Day. In these programmes the culture of Sindh and traditional hospitality were introduced by organizing in a Mach Kachri. This step of HRPF has further increased the culture and hospitality among the people of Sindh. Our aim is to promote the culture and the skillfull people in Sindh as they can work with great intrest.



10/12/2023

HRPF organized two events for the sake of awareness of Human Rights on the occasion of International Human Rights Day on December 10, 2023 at Faiz Ganj . In these programs the workers of HRPF were made aware of fundamental human rights and the workers were instructed to send the message to their area. The main purpose of the programs was to aware the people by thir basic and fundamental rights.



15/12/2023

HRPF arranged free camp at Azeez din Punjabi village, an area where hepatitis was spread widely and causing deaths. The team of HRPF arranged a camp in which more than 196 people were vaccinated for Hepatitis B. After the vaccination it was hoped that the hepatitis B ratio will be successfully dropped down. All this happened with the support of HRPF team efforts.



01/01/2024

An important meeting of HRPF Exicutive Committee members was held in Sehwan Tehsil of Jamshoro District under the chairmanship of Central Chairman Mehboob Chang on behalf of the Human Rights Protection Forum, in which the HRPF members were instructed to collect donations for winter clothes, rations and other necessary items for the poor people and were also instructed to monitor human rights violations.



15/01/2024

Human Rights Protection Forum members organized the second Hepatitis B vaccination camp at Azeez din Punjabi village, an area of Pacca Chang. In which 203 people were again protected from the dangerous disease. This small service of Human Rights Protection Forum will try to reduce the incidence of diseases like Hepatitis B. 15/02/2024

Human Rights Protection Forum members organized the third Hepatitis B vaccination camp at Azeez din Punjabi village, an area of Pacca Chang. 06/03/2024

Eid clothes were distributed to 450 deserving children and adults in Faiz ganj areas by collecting donations from the members of the Human Rights Protection Forum. The aim of providing clothes to the poor was to bring smiles on their faces and provide a pleasant environment by removing the feeling of poverty. This series will continue in the future for the sake of God. This has been possible with the donations of the members of HRPF.



14/04/2024

With the donation of members of the Human Rights Protection Forum, iftar was arranged for the breadwinners on a daily basis at the central head office, in which 200 people came to break their fast every day. In the 29-day of program, 5000 people were provided with iftar. The main purpose was to provide an honourable food to needy ones for the sake of God. 01/05/2024
